“As of Fiscal Year 2004, almost 42 million people now receive Medicare benefits,” notes Jack M. Shapiro, internationally-known healthcare marketing consultant, author, broadcaster and futurist. “In 1975, this was just 25 million people, a gain of 68% in a decade. Medicare benefits (not counting administrative costs) now amount to almost \$300 billion per year, a gain of 24% from the 2001 level of \$237 billion.

“The rise in Medicare benefits is even outstripping growth in the number of people entering the system. For example, from just FY 2003 to 2004, the number of people in Medicare grew by 1.7%, but the benefits expended grew by 7.9% in that one year.

“Two big cost elements will affect Medicare in the coming years: the advent of the new Medicare drug benefits starting in 2006 and the flood of Baby Boomers entering the Medicare system in 2011,” Shapiro observes. “You can then add another 35 million people to Medicare’s rolls between 2011 and 2020 when there could be 70 million people in the system.

“Many people also do not realize that non-elderly recipients who are disabled with certain disorders also receive Medicare. This now number just over 6 million people, about 15% of all Medicare recipients.”
